
PROPOSALS WITH A LOCAL RESIDENTS AND BUSINESS-FIRST APPROACH

40% affordable on site, with 26 family homes for 135 people on the council's waiting list.



New space for charities and local groups.



222 co-living bedrooms for singles and couples, designed for day-to-day needs.



2 community bedrooms for those who need temporary or emergency accommodation, available at reduced rates.



Re-provision of employment floor space, with affordable workspace.



Improvements to Grove Passage and the surrounding area to provide a safer, cleaner area.
